Established in March 2019 the Steering Committee implements the [United Nations International Decade for People of African Descent](#) (2015-2024) in Ireland and works with members of the African Descent Community and other stakeholders in the public and private sectors to establish key projects and activities to be implemented during the [Decade](#). The Steering Committee liaises with Government Departments and represents the views and suggestions on behalf of the African Descent Community and gives input on projects to be undertaken in the implementation of the Decade. The Committee also ensures an effective voice for people of African Descent that is acknowledged by the state, the political system and other sectors (public and private) at local, regional, national and international levels. The Committee informs and influences policy on three key major areas required to be addressed in the Decade - Recognition, Justice and Development of the people of African descent in Ireland and Monitors and evaluates achievements, successes, outcomes and challenges.
